An Act to enable the Minister of Health to grant a lease of the Mareeba Babies Hospital to The Adelaide Children's Hospital Incorporated.

[Assented to 29th November, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Mareeba Babies Hospital Lease Act, 1951".

Interpretation.

2. In this Act "Mareeba Babies Hospital" means the land, buildings and premises at Woodville known as the Mareeba Babies Hospital.

Power to grant lease.

- 3. (1) The Minister of Health may grant to The Adelaide Children's Hospital Incorporated a lease of all or any part of the Mareeba Babies Hospital.
- (2) Any such lease shall be for such term and shall reserve such rent (if any) and contain such terms, conditions and provisoes as are agreed between the parties.
- (3) Any such lease may contain a provision conferring on the lessee a licence to use any chattels in the Mareeba Babies Hospital for such period and on such terms and conditions as to payment and otherwise as are agreed between the parties.
- (4) Any such lease may be granted by the Minister of Health under his official title without specifying the name of the

Minister in office for the time being, and may, if it is so expressed in the lease, be binding on the successors in title of the Minister of Health.

4. The Adelaide Children's Hospital Incorporated shall have power to accept and be bound by any lease granted under this Children's Hospital. Act and maintain and use the leased land and buildings as a hospital.
