An Act to amend the Municipal Corporations  
Acts, 1923 to 1929.

[Assented to, November 6th, 1930.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,  
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as  
follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Municipal Corporations Act Amendment Act, 1930". Short titles.

(2) The Municipal Corporations Acts, 1923 to 1929, and this Act may be cited together as the "Municipal Corporations Acts, 1923 to 1930".

(3) The Municipal Corporations Act, 1923, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1558 of 1923

2. Section 417 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of the said section being read as subsection (1) thereof):— Amendment of principal Act, s. 417—  
Remission of fine.

(2) In any case in which the Council is of opinion that the addition of any such fine would inflict undue hardship, the Council may, by resolution passed in respect of the particular case, reduce the amount of, or altogether remit, any such fine which is added at any time within one year after the passing of the Municipal Corporations Act Amendment Act, 1930, or which is added at any time before the said passing in respect of any rate payable during the period of twelve months ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty.
