An Act to amend the MFP Development Act 1992.

[Assented to 21 November 1996]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *MFP Development (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 1996*.
- (2) The *MFP Development Act 1992* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of s. 15—Composition of Corporation

3. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) "not less than 9 and not more than 14" and substituting "not more than 7";
- (b) by striking out from subsection (1)(b) "after consultation with the Commonwealth Minister";
- (c) by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

(2) The membership of the Corporation must include persons who will, in the opinion of the State Minister, provide expertise in areas relevant to the operations of the Corporation.;

- (d) by striking out subsections (5) and (6).

Amendment of s. 26—Composition of Advisory Committee

4. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) "not less than 9 and not more than 12 members" and substituting "eight members".

Amendment of s. 27—Procedures of Advisory Committee

5. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

(2) Five members of the Advisory Committee constitute a quorum of the Committee and no business may be transacted at a meeting of the Committee unless a quorum is present.

Transitional provision

6. The offices of all members of the Corporation and the Advisory Committee become vacant on the commencement of this section.
