### No. 78 of 1969

An Act to amend the Mental Health Act, 1935-1968.

[Assented to 11th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Mental Health Act Amendment Act, 1969". Short titles.

(2) The Mental Health Act, 1935-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Mental Health Act, 1935-1969".

(3) The Mental Health Act, 1935-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 87 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsections :—

(5) The Treasurer may, on the recommendation of the Minister and on the application of the holder of a licence under this section, from time to time, on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Treasurer guarantee the repayment of any advance or loan made or proposed to be made by any person approved by the Treasurer to the holder of the licence, where the advance or loan is or is to be made for the purpose of carrying out such works or the purchase of such property approved by the Minister as would be necessary to comply with any condition imposed under this section.

(6) A guarantee shall not be made under subsection (5) of this section unless the Director or some other person appointed by the Minister has furnished the Minister with a report in writing on such matters as the Minister has required for the purposes of dealing with the application.
