*An Act to regulate the Sale of Land in the Agricultural Areas of Mount Muirhead and Mayurra.*

[Assented to, 6th February, 1872.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to regulate the sale of land in the Preamble.  
Agricultural Areas of Mount Muirhead and Mayurra—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding a certain Proclamation, published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* of the twenty-fifth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, under the provisions of the Act No. 14 of 1868-9, proclaiming and declaring the Agricultural Area No. 1, Mount Muirhead, and a certain other Proclamation, published in the said *Gazette*, proclaiming and declaring the Agricultural Area No. 10, Mayurra, or anything contained in the said Act, No. 14 of 1868-9, the lands comprised in the said Agricultural Areas or either of them shall not be open for selection under the provisions of the said Act, or any Act amending the same, at a lower price than Two Pounds per acre: Provided that this Act shall not affect the validity of any selection heretofore made, or any matter or thing heretofore lawfully done, under the provisions of the said Acts, or either of them.

Lands in Agricultural Areas of Mount Muirhead and Mayurra not to be open for selection at less than Two Pounds per acre.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
