An Act to amend the Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1955.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Milk short titles. Supply Act Amendment Act, 1956".
- (2) The Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1956".
- (3) The Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of s. 37a of the principal Act after section 37 thereof: principal Act after section 37 thereof:—

- 37a. (1) The board may, if it considers it necessary permits to to do so, issue a permit to any holder of a milk treatment purchase milk. licence authorizing him to buy chilled milk from any proprietor of a dairy produce factory or milk depot in any part of the State.
- (2) A permit so issued may contain terms and conditions as to any one or more of the following matters:—
 - (a) the duration of the permit;
 - (b) the quantity of milk to be bought pursuant to the permit;

- (c) the quality of such milk and the temperature to which it must be chilled before being delivered to the holder of the permit;
- (d) the price to be paid for the milk by the holder of the permit; and
- (e) any conditions as to transport of the milk, or other matters which the board deems it necessary to insert in the permit, in the interests of the public.
- (3) If a condition of a permit is broken or not observed, the board may revoke the permit.
- (4) Milk purchased in accordance with a permit issued under this section shall for the purposes of section 29 of this Act be deemed to be milk produced by the holder of a milk producer's licence.
- (5) This section shall continue in force until the thirtyfirst day of December, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, and no longer.
