An Act to amend the Manningham Recreation Ground Act, 1936.

[Assented to 21st November, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Manningham Recreation Ground Act Amendment Act, 1963".

(2) The Manningham Recreation Ground Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Manningham Recreation Ground Act, 1936-1963".

(3) The Manningham Recreation Ground Act, 1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Development of portion of the land as a playground and pleasure grounds.**

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection:—

(3) The Council may grant a lease of portion of the land mentioned in subsection (1) of this section for any term not exceeding twenty-one years to be used as club rooms by the Returned Sailors', Soldiers' and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia (South Australian Branch) Incorporated and may, from time to time, renew any such lease for a further term not exceeding twenty-one years. Such

lease may be upon such terms and subject to such rents, covenants, provisions, conditions, and reservations, as the Council thinks fit.
