An Act to further amend the Marine Stores Act, 1898-9, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 1st, 1921.]

B it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Marine Stores Act short titles, Amendment Act, 1921."

(2) The Marine Stores Act, 1898-9, the Marine Stores Act No. 716 of 1898-9. Amendment Act, 1899, and this Act may be cited together as the No. 719 of 1899. "Marine Stores Acts, 1898 to 1921."

2. Section 3 of the Marine Stores Act, 1898-9, is amended by Amendment of Act, substituting for the words "One Shilling" therein the words "Five 716 of 1898-9, s. 3-Shillings ".

Collector's licence fee to be Five Shillings.
