An Act to amend the Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954.

[Assented to 14th November, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act Amendment Act, 1957".
- (2) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954-1957".
- (3) The Metropolitan Transport Advisory Council Act, 1954, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking principal Act— out the word "fifty-seven" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty-nine".

4. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking Amendment of out the word "fifty-seven" in the second line of subsection (5) principal Act and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty-nine".

Directions concerning railways and tramways.
