An Act to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959.

[Assented to 14 September 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles Act Amendment Act (No. 4), 1989.

(2) The Motor Vehicles Act, 1959, is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

1a. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Insurance premiums to be paid on applications for registration

2. Section 99a of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (8) "fourteen" and substituting "30".

Duty to insure against third party risks

3. Section 102 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subsection (2) ", but not less than the maximum of a division 11 fine";
- (b) by striking out from subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of subsection (2) "not less than three months and";

and

(c) by striking out subsection (2a).
