An Act to authorise the construction of certain Works for the Storage and Distribution of Water, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, November 15th, 1917.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Moorook Waterworks Act, 1917." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Waterworks Act, 1882, and all Acts incorporated with that Act, except sections 110, 114, 115, 116, 117, and 118 of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act. Incorporation with other Acts. No. 6 of 1847.

3. The Commissioner of Waterworks may, out of moneys voted by Parliament for the purpose— Commissioner of Waterworks may construct Moorook Water Scheme.

- (a) construct and maintain the waterworks known as the Moorook Waterworks, and all other works which from time to time are found to be necessary or convenient in connection therewith, within the water district to be called the "Moorook Water District," shown and margined yellow on the plan deposited on the twenty-sixth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventeen, in the office of the Surveyor-General, marked "Moorook Waterworks, Moorook Water District," signed "Charles A. Bayer, Hydraulic Engineer," and dated the eighteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventeen, and
- (b) construct

(b) construct and maintain such works and do such things as from time to time are found to be necessary or convenient for conveying and distributing the water stored in the said waterworks to and through the said district.

Districts which may be supplied.

4. The water stored in the said waterworks may be used—

(a) for the supply of the Moorook Water District, and

(b) for the further supply of any other water district.

Moorook Water District constituted a water district under the Waterworks Act.

5. The Moorook Water District is hereby constituted and declared to be a water district for the purposes of the Waterworks Act, 1882.

Meaning of Moorook Water District.

6. In this Act the term "Moorook Water District" means the Moorook Water District referred to in section 3 of this Act, with any additions which at any time may be made thereto by proclamation under the Waterworks Act, 1882, or the said Moorook Water District as the same for the time being exists in consequence of any alterations of the boundaries thereof so made.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
