**AN ORDINANCE for the Naturalization of certain Persons
Natives of Germany.**

WHEREAS the undermentioned persons Natives of Germany ^{Pro...} have applied to be admitted to the privileges of British subjects, and it is fit and proper that their request should be granted :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof: That

be and they are hereby naturalized and enabled to purchase and hold lands and to enjoy all other the privileges of natural born British subjects.
