An Act to amend the Narcotic and Psychotropic Drugs Act,
1934-1977.

[Assented to 13th April, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Narcotic and Psychotropic Drugs Act Amendment Act, 1978".
- (2) The Narcotic and Psychotropic Drugs Act, 1934-1977, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Narcotic and Psychotropic Drugs Act, 1934-1978".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out paragraph (d) of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
 - (d) regulating or prohibiting the issue of prescriptions containing any drug to which this Act applies, the dispensing of any such prescriptions or the supply of any such drug thereunder;
 - (b) by inserting after paragraph (k) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:—
 - (l) providing for—
 - (i) the cancellation, withdrawal or suspension of any licence or authority issued or granted under the regulations;
 - (ii) appeals against the cancellation, withdrawal or suspension of any such licence or authority;
- and

(iii) the re-issue or re-granting of any such licence or authority.;

and

(c) by striking out subsection (2).

3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage “employed in the public service”;

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage “or the person employed in the public service” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “or other person authorized under subsection (1) of this section”.
