An Act to amend the Nurses Registration Act,
1920-1966.

[Assented to 19th December, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Nurses Registration Act Amendment Act, 1968".

(2) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1968".

(3) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Paragraph (b) of section 33nd of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "eighteen" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seventeen".
