An Act to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1963.

[Assented to 5th November, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the “Nurses Registration Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1964”. Short titles.

(2) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1963, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the “Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1964”.

(3) The Nurses Registration Act, 1920-1963, is hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Subsections (3), (4) and (5) of section 21 of the principal Act are repealed. Amendment of principal Act, s. 21.

4. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:— Amendment of principal Act, s. 22.

(b) in the case of an application for registration as a nurse, psychiatric nurse or mental deficiency nurse, is over

twenty years of age, or, in the case of an application for registration as a midwife, is over twenty-one years of age.
