## An Act to amend the Ombudsman Act, 1972.

[Assented to 19 April 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Ombudsman Act Amendment Act, 1984."
- (2) The Ombudsman Act, 1972, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 18—
Procedure on investigations

- 2. Section 18 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and substituting the following subsections:
  - (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Part, the Ombudsman may make a preliminary investigation of an administrative act to determine whether he should proceed with a full investigation of that act.
  - (1a) When the Ombudsman has determined that he should make a full investigation of an administrative act he shall, before proceeding with the investigation, inform the principal officer of the Department, Authority or proclaimed Council of his decision.
