An Act to authorise the construction of certain Waterworks to increase the Water Supply of the City of Adelaide, and other places suburban or adjacent thereto.

[*Assented to, December 19th, 1891.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Onkaparinga Waterworks Act, 1891." Short title.

2. "The Commissioner of Waterworks" may, out of any moneys voted by Parliament for the purpose, construct and maintain, for the further water supply of the City of Adelaide and other places suburban or adjacent thereto, the waterworks, and all other works which from time to time may be found to be necessary in connection therewith, known as the "Onkaparinga Water Scheme Happy Valley Reservoir;" within the limits of deviation shown on the plan of such waterworks deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, and marked "Onkaparinga Water Scheme Happy Valley Reservoir," and signed by the Engineer-in-Chief. Commissioner of Waterworks may construct waterworks at Happy Valley.

3. This Act shall be incorporated with and shall form part of "The Waterworks Act, 1882," and of any Acts therewith incorporated, Incorporation.
