An Act to amend the Prisons Act, 1936-1974.

*[Assented to 27th November, 1975]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prisons Act Amendment Act, 1975".
- (2) The Prisons Act, 1936-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prisons Act, 1936-1975".

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

(1a) Where in any Act or document or in any regulation, rule, or by-law or in any other instrument, whether that Act was enacted, or that document, regulation, rule, by-law or instrument was made before or after the commencement of the Prisons Act Amendment Act, 1975, a reference direct or indirect is made to the Comptroller of Prisons, that reference shall, where such a construction is applicable, be construed and read as a reference to the Director.
