An Act to amend the Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1966.

[Assented to 30th November, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Act Amendment Act, 1972".
- (2) The Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1972".
- (3) The Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act s. 39— Permanent qualifications for registrations.

- 3. Section 39 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subparagraph (i) of paragraph (c) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subparagraph:—
 - (i) he holds, or has qualified for the award of, the Diploma of Physiotherapy of the University of Adelaide or he holds, or has qualified for the award of, the Diploma in Technology in Physiotherapy of the South Australian Institute of Technology;

4. Section 39b of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of s. 39b of principal Act.

5. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage ", not Annual subscriptions. exceeding twelve dollars,";

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "of three dollars at such time as is" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "of such amount and at such time as are".
