An Act to amend the provisions of the Police Act, 1916, relating to contributions by Police Districts towards the maintenance of foot police.

[Assented to, 10th October, 1935.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Act Amendment Act, 1935". Short titles.
- (2) The Police Acts, 1916 to 1934, and this Act may be cited together as the "Police Acts, 1916 to 1935".
2. This Act is incorporated with the Police Acts, 1916 to 1934, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. This Act takes effect as from the first of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-five. Commencement of Act.
4. Section 30 of the Police Act, 1916, is amended as follows :— Amendment of Police Act, 1916, s. 30—
 - (a) Subsection (1) is repealed and the following subsection enacted in lieu thereof :—
 - (1) Whenever any foot police are stationed for a longer period than three months in the year in any Police District, that Police District shall pay to the Treasurer in aid of the General Revenue of Amount of contributions by Police Districts.

the State on account of such maintenance a sum calculated as prescribed in this section; and the remainder of that cost shall be paid out of the General Revenue of the State. The sum to be paid under this section by a Police District shall be a sum not exceeding three-eighths of the entire cost.

- (b) Subsection (2) is amended by striking out the words "one-half cost" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "amount".

5. Section 33 of the Police Act, 1916, is amended as follows:—

- (a) The words "as or" and "one-half" occurring in the third line of subsection (1) are struck out:
- (b) The following subsection is inserted at the end of the section:—

(3) If any municipal corporation or district council has (whether before or after the commencement of the Police Act Amendment Act, 1935), levied a special rate for the purpose of paying any sum which it is by this Act required to contribute towards the maintenance of any foot police, and the produce of such special rate is or will be in excess of the sum required to be so contributed, the corporation or council may, if it thinks fit, expend such excess in any way and for any purpose in or for which it might expend any other part of its revenue.

6. Section 36 of the Police Act, 1916, is amended by striking out the words "one-half cost of" in the sixth line of subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof "amount to be contributed by the Police District towards".
