An Act to amend the law relating to persons apprenticed to pharmaceutical chemists registered pursuant to the Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pharmacy Act Amend- short titles. ment Act, 1937".
- (2) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Pharmacy Act, 1935-1937".
- (3) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1936, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. Part V. of the principal Act is amended by inserting Amendment of therein after section 33 the following section:—

after section 33 the following section:

33a. Section 223 of the Industrial Code, 1920, shall not non-application of section 223 of the Industrial Code, 1920, shall be deemed never to have applied to any of the Industrial Code, 1920. apply and shall be deemed never to have applied to any apprentice to a registered pharmaceutical chemist.
