An Act to amend the Prices Act, 1948-1950.

[Assented to 25th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prices Act Amendment Short titles. Act, 1951 ".
- (2) The Prices Act, 1948-1950, as enacted by this Act, may be cited as the "Prices Act, 1948-1951".
- (3) The Prices Act, 1948-1950, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Section 47 of the principal Act is amended by inserting Amendment of at the end thereof the following subsection (the previous part principal Actof section 47 being read as subsection (1) thereof):—

Evidence of rates for services.

- (2) A certificate signed by the Commissioner stating the rate, fixed by or under this Act, for the supply of any declared services, and in force on any named day, shall be prima facie evidence of the fact so certified.
- 4. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of principal Act after section 47 thereof:—

47a. (1) Any notice permitted or required to be given service of notices. or served under this Act on any person may be given or served—

principal Act—

- (a) by delivering the notice personally to that person;
- (b) by leaving the notice for that person at his last or most usual place of abode or business with some other person, apparently an inmate thereof or employed thereat, and apparently not less than sixteen years of age; or
- (c) by post.
- (2) Service of a notice on a director, manager, secretary, or other principal or responsible officer of a company or body corporate shall be deemed to be service on that company or body corporate.

Amendment of a, 53 of principal Act— Duration of Act. 5. Section 53 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "fifty-two" at the end thereof and inserting in its place the word "fifty-three".
