An Act to amend the Prices Act, 1948-1950.

[Assented to 25th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Prices Act Amendment Act, 1951 ". Short titles.
- (2) The Prices Act, 1948-1950, as enacted by this Act, may be cited as the " Prices Act, 1948-1951 ".
- (3) The Prices Act, 1948-1950, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Section 47 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the previous part of section 47 being read as subsection (1) thereof) :— Amendment of s. 47 of principal Act— Evidence of rates for services.
 - (2) A certificate signed by the Commissioner stating the rate, fixed by or under this Act, for the supply of any declared services, and in force on any named day, shall be *prima facie* evidence of the fact so certified.
4. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 47 thereof :— Enactment of s. 47a of principal Act—
 - 47a. (1) Any notice permitted or required to be given or served under this Act on any person may be given or served— Service of notices.

(a) by delivering the notice personally to that person ;
or

(b) by leaving the notice for that person at his last
or most usual place of abode or business with
some other person, apparently an inmate
thereof or employed thereat, and apparently
not less than sixteen years of age ; or

(c) by post.

(2) Service of a notice on a director, manager, secretary,
or other principal or responsible officer of a company or
body corporate shall be deemed to be service on that com-
pany or body corporate.

5. Section 53 of the principal Act is amended by striking
out the word "fifty-two" at the end thereof and inserting
in its place the word "fifty-three".
