An Act to amend the Prices Act, 1948-1977.

[Assented to 30th March, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prices Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.
  - (2) The Prices Act, 1948-1977, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
  - (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prices Act, 1948-1978".
2. Section 18a of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (d) of subsection (1) the passage "any complaint from a consumer of". Amendment of principal Act, s. 18a—  
Functions and powers of the Commissioner.
