An Act to amend the Phylloxera Act, 1936.

[Assented to 24 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Phylloxera Act Amendment Act, 1984". Short title.

(2) The Phylloxera Act, 1936, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsections: Amendment of s. 7—
Continuance of board.

(2) The board—

(a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal;

(b) shall be capable of suing and being sued;

(c) shall be capable of acquiring, holding, dealing with and disposing of real and personal property;

and

(d) shall be capable of acquiring or incurring any other rights or liabilities.

(3) Where a document appears to bear the common seal of the board, it shall be presumed in any legal proceedings, in the absence of proof to the contrary, that the document has been duly executed by the board.
