An Act to amend the Pharmacy Act, 1935-1965.

[Assented to 16th November, 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pharmacy Act Amendment Act, 1967".

(2) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Pharmacy Act, 1935-1967".

(3) The Pharmacy Act, 1935-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Subsection (1) of section 22 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subparagraph (b) of paragraph va thereof after the words "South Australia" therein occurring the words "or holds a diploma in pharmacy of the South Australian Institute of Technology".
