An Act to amend the Prohibited Areas (Application of State Laws) Act, 1952.

[Assented to 13th September, 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prohibited Areas (Application of State Laws) Act Amendment Act, 1973". Short titles.

(2) The Prohibited Areas (Application of State Laws) Act, 1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prohibited Areas (Application of State Laws) Act, 1952-1973".

(3) The Prohibited Areas (Application of State Laws) Act, 1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "definition of "road" in Parts II, IIA, III, IV, V and VI of the Road Traffic Act, 1934-1952" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "definition of "road" in the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1972 and the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1972";

and

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—

Application of certain Acts to prohibited areas.

(b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "Police Act, 1936-1951," and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Police Offences Act, 1953-1972,".
