An Act to authorize the granting to the Council of Education of portion of certain Park Lands.

[Assented to, 21st December, 1877.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to authorize the granting to the Preamble. Council of Education of portion of certain Park Lands-Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. The Governor, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, may Park Lands may be grant in fee simple to the Council of Education, as sites for school granted to Council. buildings, any convenient portion of the Corporate Town of Kadina, called or known as Park Lands, not exceeding in the whole five Provided that no grant of any such lands shall be made acres: unless on the written request of the Corporation of the said town, such request being testified by writing, sealed with the common seal of such Corporation, and signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Town Clerk thereof.

2. From and after the making of any such grant the land granted Land granted shall shall cease to be reserved or dedicated as a place for public cease to be reserved. recreation and amusement.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
