An Act to amend the Potato Marketing Act, 1948-1964.

[Assented to 1st December, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Potato Marketing Act Amendment Act, 1966". Short title.
 - (2) The Potato Marketing Act, 1948-1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Potato Marketing Act, 1948-1966".
 - (3) The Potato Marketing Act, 1948-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Subsection (1) of section 20 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein after paragraph (b) thereof the following paragraph :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 20—
Control of sale, delivery and price of potatoes.
- (b1) prohibit either absolutely or except on such terms and conditions as the board thinks fit any person or class of persons from buying or taking delivery of potatoes or any class of potatoes from any person or class of persons other than the board or class of persons nominated by the board.

4. The principal Act is amended by striking out each passage therein representing an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Coinage Act* 1909-1947 of the Commonwealth and inserting in lieu thereof in each case a passage representing the equivalent amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the *Currency Act* 1965 of the Commonwealth calculated on the basis of the equivalents specified in subsection (4) of section 8 of that Act.
