An Act to amend the Police Offences Act, 1953-1976.

[Assented to 16th December, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles,

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Offences Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1976".
- (2) The Police Offences Act, 1953-1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Offences Act, 1953-1976".

Commence

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Repeal of a, 9 of principal Act, 3. Section 9 of the principal Act is repealed.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 9a— Consumption and sale of methylated 4. Section 9a of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (1), (2) and (3).
