An Act to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1949.

[Assented to 16th December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act Amendment Act, 1954". Short titles.

(2) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1949".

(3) The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1936-1949, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 5 thereof :— Enactment of s. 5a of principal Act—

5a. (1) Any person who—

(a) promotes, arranges, conducts, assists in, receives money for, or takes part in, any event in the course of which captive birds are liberated from captivity for the purpose of being shot at; or

(b) being the owner, occupier, or person in charge of any premises, permits such premises to be used for any purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this subsection,

Prohibition of shooting at captive birds.

shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

(2) In this section "event" means any meeting, competition, exhibition, display, practice, or pastime.
