## No. 2265.

An Act to consolidate the Acts providing for the  
Payment of Members of Parliament.

*[Assented to, 13th August, 1936.]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South  
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament  
thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1936". Short title.

2. The following Acts are repealed, namely :—

3. Every member of Parliament, whether a member of the  
Legislative Council or of the House of Assembly, shall, except  
as provided by section 6, be entitled to receive payment in  
respect of his services in the discharge of his parliamentary  
duties, at the rate of four hundred pounds per annum.

4. Whenever the term of office of any member of the Legislative Council or the House of Assembly, expires by effluxion of time or by reason of the House of Assembly being dissolved by the Governor, then payment at the rate of four hundred pounds per annum shall continue to be payable to that member from the time of the expiration of his term of office as aforesaid until a successor is elected in his place.

5. Payments under this Act shall be made out of the General Revenue of the State on the first day of every calendar month.

Deductions  
from payment.

6. No member whilst in the receipt out of the General Revenue of the State of any official salary or annual sum, shall be entitled to receive any payment under this Act, except in so far as that payment exceeds the amount of that official salary or annual sum :

Provided that this section shall not affect any provision of the Public Works Standing Committee Act, 1927.
