An Act to amend the Payment of Members of
Parliament Act, 1948-1953.

[Assented to 14th November, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act Amendment Act, 1957".

(2) The Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1953, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1957".

(3) The Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1953, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following line:—

Deputy Leader of the Opposition,
House of Assembly Two hundred and
fifty pounds.
