An Act to amend the Prevention of Pollution of Waters by Oil Act, 1961-1969.

[Assented to 19th October, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prevention of Pollution of Waters by Oil Act Amendment Act, 1972".
- (2) The Prevention of Pollution of Waters by Oil Act, 1961-1969, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prevention of Pollution of Waters by Oil Act, 1961-1972".
- (3) The Prevention of Pollution of Waters by Oil Act, 1961-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commence-

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, a. 5— Discharge of

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "one thousand pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "fifty thousand dollars".

4. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from Amendment of principal Act, subsection (5) the passage "one thousand dollars" and inserting in \$18 lieu thereof the passage "ten thousand dollars".

Equipment in ships to prevent oil pollution.

5. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from Amendment of subsection (7) the passage "one thousand dollars" and inserting in 5.9lieu thereof the passage "five thousand dollars".

Keeping of Oil Records.

6. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 10-

(a) by inserting in subsection (1) after the passage "against investigation this section" the passage "and shall be liable upon of oil, etc. conviction to a fine not exceeding ten thousand dollars";

Reporting and

(b) by striking out from subsection (6) the word "The", being the first word in that subsection, and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Except as otherwise provided by this section, the";

and

- (c) by striking out from subsection (6) the passage "four hundred" dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "two thousand dollars".
- 7. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in Amendment of principal Act, based on (6) after the passage "may be prescribed" the passage 11subsection (6) after the passage "may be prescribed" the passage ", and, if any owner or occupier contravenes or fails to comply with Pacilities." any such regulation, he shall be guilty of an offence against this section and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars".

8. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of principal Act, from subsection (3) the passage "four hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "two thousand dollars".

Restrictions on transfer of oil at night.

9. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of principal Act. from subsection (1) the passage "in such regulations may prescribe for the payment of such fees and the imposition of such penalties for breach as it deems appropriate" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "and, in any regulations made under any power conferred by this Act, may provide for the payment of any fee or fees and may prescribe a fine, not exceeding two thousand dollars, or other penalty for a contravention of or a failure to comply with any provision of those regulations".

Regulations.

Amendment or principal Act, s. 14— Inspection and Report, 10. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "four hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "two thousand dollars".
