An Act to fix the salaries of certain public officers and to repeal the Public Officers Salaries Act, 1952, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 17th December, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Officers Salaries Act, 1953".

Repeal.

2. The Public Officers Salaries Act, 1952, is repealed.

Salaries of certain officers.

- 3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any Act—
 - (a) the salary of the Auditor-General shall be at the rate of two thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds a year;
 - (b) the salary of the Public Service Commissioner shall be at the rate of two thousand six hundred pounds a year;
 - (c) the salary of the Commissioner of Police shall be at the rate of two thousand four hundred and fifty pounds a year.

If the Public Service Commissioner holds office as the chairman or a member of The Public Service Board, his salary as fixed by this section shall be in addition to such salary as the Governor may declare to be payable to him in respect of the said office.

4. The salaries of the Auditor-General, the Public Service Financial provision. Commissioner and the Commissioner of Police under this Act shall be a charge upon and payable out of the general revenue of the State, which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly.

5. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on commencement of Act. the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.
