An Act to amend the Pest Plants Act, 1976.

[Assented to 7 November 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pest Plants Act Amendment Act, 1985". Short title.

(2) The Pest Plants Act, 1976, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fifteenth day of April, 1976. Commencement.

3. The following section is inserted after section 41 of the principal Act: Insertion of new s. 41a.

41a. A control board may enter into an agreement with an owner of land or with another control board for the destruction or control of pest plants by the board on that land, whether the land is inside or outside the control area of the board. Control board may contract with owners or other control boards.

4. Section 56 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted: Repeal of s. 56 and substitution of new section.

56. (1) No personal liability shall attach to—

- (a) a member of the Commission or of a control board;
 - (b) an officer or employee of the Commission or of a control board;
 - (c) an authorized officer;
- or
- (d) a person acting at the direction of the Commission or of a control board,

Immunity from liability.

for an act or omission on his part or on the part of the Commission or control board, in good faith, in the exercise or discharge, or purported exercise or discharge, of a power, function or duty vested in or imposed upon him, the Commission or the control board by this Act.

(2) A liability that would, but for subsection (1), lie against a person shall lie against the Crown.
