An Act to amend the Police Pensions Act, 1971.

[Assented to 31st August, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1972". Short titles.

(2) The Police Pensions Act, 1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Pensions Act, 1971-1972".

(3) The Police Pensions Act, 1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting immediately after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

(1a) A pension of a widow, that pursuant to any of the repealed Acts ceased on her re-marriage, shall, if she again became or becomes a widow, subject to subsection (2) of this section, again be payable on and from the day of commencement of this Act if she

again became a widow before that commencement or on and from the day on which she again becomes a widow if that event occurred or occurs on or after that commencement.;

(b) by inserting in subsection (2) after the passage “referred to in subsection (1)” the passage “or subsection (1a)”;

(c) by inserting in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) after the passage “subsection (1)” the passage “or subsection (1a)”;

and

(d) by inserting immediately after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) Where pursuant to this section a widow’s pension again became or becomes payable that pension shall from time to time be payable at the rate at which it would have been payable had it not ceased or, as the case may be, ceased to be payable.
