An Act to amend the Police Pensions Act, 1971.

[Assented to 24 October 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Pensions Act Amendment Act, 1985". Short title.

(2) The Police Pensions Act, 1971, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1986. Commencement.

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage " , out of moneys to be provided by Parliament,"; Amendment of s. 9— Contributions by the Government.

and

(b) by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:

(3) The moneys required for the purpose of contributions by the Government under this section shall be provided out of the General Revenue of the State which is appropriated by this section to the necessary extent.
