## No. 7 of 1981

An Act to revest in the Crown certain portions of the land vested in the Port Pirie Trotting and Racing Club Incorporated and for other purposes.

[Assented to 5 March 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Port Pirie Racecourse Land Revestment Short title. Act, 1981".
  - 2. In this Act—

Interpretation.

- "the Club" means the Port Pirie Trotting and Racing Club Incorporated:
- "the land" means the land vested in the club by the principal Act except so much of that land as has reverted to the Crown under the revesting Acts:
- "the principal Act" means the Port Pirie Racecourse Site Act, 1946:
- "the re-vesting Acts" means the Port Pirie Racecourse Land Revestment Act, 1960, and the Port Pirie Racecourse Land Revestment Act, 1965.
- 3. (1) Those portions of the land comprising sections 1282, 1283 and of the land to revert to the Land to revert to the Crown. 1284 Hundred of Pirie shall, upon the commencement of this Act—

- (a) cease to be vested in the club;
- (b) revert to the Crown freed and discharged from any estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand of the Club or any other person;

and

- (c) become Crown lands within the meaning, and for the purposes, of the Crown Lands Act, 1929-1980.
- (2) The principal Act shall continue to apply to the remainder of the land as if a reference to the defined land in the principal Act were a reference to the remainder of the land.

(3) The Registrar-General shall upon the application of the Club or the Minister of Lands, and upon production of such duplicate certificates of title, or other document as the Registrar-General may require, make such entries and notations in the Register Book as may be necessary to evidence the reversion to the Crown of land under this section, and may issue to the Club a new certificate of title in respect of the remainder of the land.
