An Act to amend the Police Regulation Act,
1952-1955.

[Assented to 7th November, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act Amendment Act, 1963". Short titles.

(2) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1955, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Police Regulation Act, 1952-1963".

(3) The Police Regulation Act, 1952-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(1) Any person who, without lawful excuse—

(a) wears the uniform of a member of the police force of any State, or of any other police force in Australia or another country ; or

(b) by word or conduct represents himself to be a member of any such police force, shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty : Twenty-five pounds ;

(b) by striking out the words "the police force" in subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "any such police force" ; and

(c) by striking out subsection (3) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(3) Subsection (1) shall not prevent a person taking part in a stage play, ball or other entertainment from wearing any such uniform in the course of, and for the purpose of, that play, ball or other entertainment.
