An Act to reduce the Salaries of Certain Persons in the Employment of the Public Service.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1930.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof as with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Salaries Act, 1930".

Short title.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act, and notwith- Reduction of certain standing any contract or agreement, the salaries payable to the public salaries. persons holding the offices mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be the salaries set forth opposite to the names of the said offices in the third column of the said Schedule.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
