### No. 54 of 1968

An Act to amend the Public Service Act, 1967.

[Assented to 19th December, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1968". Short titles.

(2) The Public Service Act, 1967, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Public Service Act, 1967-1968".

(3) The Public Service Act, 1967, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 126 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted and inserted therein in its place :— Repeal and re-enactment of new s. 126 of principal Act—

126. (1) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or any other Act, or in any regulation thereunder, so much of the provisions of Division VIII of Part III of this Act as relates to and in relation to— Application of certain provisions of Part III to certain employees.

(a) any entitlement to long service leave ;

(b) any grant of long service leave ;

or

(c) any payment in lieu of a grant of long service leave,

under this Act, shall apply and shall be deemed always to have applied to and in relation to any person in the employ of the State otherwise than as an Officer or temporary Officer as if the service of that person in that employ were service as an Officer where the Board is of the opinion that—

(d) in the conditions of employment of that person an entitlement, grant or payment of a kind similar to that entitlement, grant or payment is not otherwise provided for ;

and

(e) the circumstances of the service or of the termination of the service of the person are analogous to the circumstances set out in those provisions under which an entitlement, grant or payment is provided for in relation to the service or termination of service of an Officer.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or any other Act or in any regulation thereunder—

(a) section 91 of this Act shall apply and shall be deemed always to have applied to and in relation to the retirement or resignation, after the commencement of this Act, of any person in the employ of the State otherwise than as an Officer as if the service of that person in that employ were service as an Officer where the Board is of the opinion that—

(i) in the conditions of service of that person a payment of a kind similar to that referred to in that section is not otherwise provided for ;

and

(ii) the retirement or resignation took place in circumstances analogous to the circumstances referred to in that section in relation to a retirement or resignation of an Officer referred to in that section ;

and

(b) section 92 of that Act shall apply and shall be deemed always to have applied to and in relation to the death, after the commencement of this Act, of any person in the employ of the

State otherwise than as an Officer as if the service of that person in that employ were service as an Officer where the Board is of the opinion that in the conditions of service of that person a payment of a kind similar to that referred to in that section is not otherwise provided for.
