An Act to amend the Pay-roll Tax Act, 1971.

[Assented to 13 March 1986]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Pay-roll Tax Act Amendment Act, 1986".

(2) The Pay-roll Tax Act, 1971, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (da) of subsection (1) the following paragraph:

(db) before 1 July, 1989, by, or on behalf of, an employer to a person employed, in accordance with the agreement between the Commonwealth and the State for the implementation of the Australian Traineeship System, under a scheme of training approved pursuant to section 27 of the Industrial and Commercial Training Act, 1981;
