#### An Act to amend the Public Works Standing Committee Act, 1927-1935.

[Assented to 25th July, 1940.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Public Works Standing Committee Act Amendment Act, 1940 " Short titles.
- (2) The Public Works Standing Committee Act, 1927-1935, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Public Works Standing Committee Act, 1927-1940 ".
- (3) The Public Works Standing Committee Act, 1927-1935, is hereinafter called " the principal Act ".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. The following section is hereby enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 25 thereof :— Enactment s. 25a of principal Act—
  - 25a. Subsection (1) of section 25 of this Act shall not apply to any Bill introduced by a Minister while Australia is at war, if the Bill bears an endorsement signed by the said Minister and certifying that all public works to which the Bill relates and which are estimated to cost, when complete, more than thirty thousand pounds, and which have not been inquired into by the committee, are works urgently required for or in connection with the carrying on of the war. Operation of s. 25 during time of war.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
