An Act to amend Act No. 13 of 1860, intituled "An Act to declare Main Lines of Road in South Australia."

Assented to, 4th August, 1865.

HEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act, No. 13 of 1860, Preamble. intituled "An Act to declare the Main Lines of Road in South Australia," in manner hereinafter provided—Be it therefore Enacted, by the Governor-in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Main Roads Amendment Act, short title. 1865."
- 2. Section No. 2 of an Act No. 13 of 1860, intituled "An Act Repeal. to declare the Main Lines of Road in South Australia," and the Schedule to the said Act shall be and the same is hereby repealed, save so far as may be necessary to support or give validity to any Act matter or thing heretofore legally done in pursuance thereof.
- 3. The lines of road more particularly set forth and described in Declaration of certain the Schedule to this Act shall and they are hereby declared to be Main Roads of the Province of South Australia, for the purposes of all Acts now or hereafter to be in force relating to or affecting the Main Roads of the said Province.

## Main Roads Amendment Act.—1865.

### SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

1. Port Road.—From the junction of North and West-terraces, Adelaide, to the south-eastern boundary of Port Adelaide Municipality.

2. Le Fevre's Peninsula Road.—From the western boundary of Port Adelaide

Municipality to the Semaphore Jetty.

3. Thebarton Bridge and Kapunda Road.—North Road, from Thebarton Bridge, by the Heart-in-Hand and Grand Junction, by Smithfield and Gawler, to Kapunda, via Grotegut, Sheoak, and Bagot's Gap.

4. Dry Creek Road.—Old North Road, from O'Connell-street, North Adelaide, by the Windmill Corner, by Gepp's Cross, to the junction of the Main North Line at the

Dry Creek.

- 5. Grand Junction Hotel and Port Causeway Road.—Road from Grand Junction Hotel, on the North Road, to the north-east angle of Alberton, to the Causeway on the Port Road.
- 6. Gepp's Cross and Port Gawler Road.—Port Gawler Road, from Gepp's Cross to Waterloo Inn.
- 7. Wallaroo and Moonta Road .- From Adelaide, by Virginia Bridge and Port Wakefield, to Wallaroo and Moonta.

8. Wakefield Road.—From Virginia to Dunn's Bridge on the Wakefield,

- 9. Virginia Bridge Road .- From Railway Station, Solisbury, by Virginia Bridge, to the River Light, and thence to Kadina.
- 10. Alma Road.—From Gawler Town, by Templer's and Light Bridge, to Forrester's, with a branch to Stockport and the Alma Plains.

11. Old North Road.-From Grotegut, via Stockport to Anstey's Corner

- 12. Kooringa and Port Wakefield Road.—Road from Kooringa to Port Wakefield. 13. North Road.—From Railway Station, Kapunda, to Kooringa, and to Melrose.
- 14. North Road (North-Western Branch).—From Kapunda, by Forrester's, to northern boundary of Hundred of Clare.
- 15. Mount Brian Road.—From Bridge to a point twenty miles on the Mount Brian
- 16. North Road (North-Eastern Branch).—From Railway Station, Freeling, to Blanchetown, vid Greenock and Truro.
- 17. Angaston Branch.—From near Nuriootpa, on the north-eastern branch of the North Road, through Angaston to North Rhine River.
- 18. Angaston Branch to South Rhine.—From Petra's Corner, by Section 431, through Terrawatta, up Flaxman's Valley, to Young's Corner, and to Section 583.

19. Kapunda and Truro Road.—From Kapunda to Truro.

20. Greenock and Bagot's Gap Road.—From Greenock to Bagot's Gap.

21. Lyndoch Valley Road. -From Railway Station, Gawler, across South Para Bridge; and from east boundary of Municipality of Gawler, via Lyndoch Valley and Tanunda, to join Blanchetown Road, at or near Nuriootpa.

22. Mount Crawford Branch.-From near Sandy Creek and Lyndoch Valley Road,

by Mount Crawford, to South Rhine.

23. North-Eastern Road.—From the junction of North and East-terraces, Adelaide, to the River Murray, viâ Teatree Gully, Gumeracka, and Stony Creek.

24. Dry Creek Branch.—From the eighth milestone, on the North-Eastern Road, until it joins main line near Grand Junction Hotel.

- 25. Smithfield Branch.—From Railway Station, Smithfield, by Maidstone, to join North-Eastern Road, at Phelp Town, Chain of Ponds.
- 26. South Branch.—Diverging from the North-East Road at the boundary of the Park Lands, at Bailey's Garden, by MacDonnell Bridge, to join the Main North-Eastern Road at Inglewood.
  - 27. From Modbury, through Golden Grove, viá Snake Gully, to Sampson's Flat. 28. Stony Creek Branch.—From Stony Creek, by Mount Pleasant, to South
- 29. Maidstone Branch.—From No. 25 Main Road, near Maidstone, to No. 22 Main
- Road, near Williamstown.

30. Main Eastern Road.—From the Maid and Magpie, vid Magill, Lobethal, and Mount Torrens, till it joins No. 23, near the twenty-eighth mile-post.

### Main Roads Amendment Act.—1865.

31. Balhannah Road.—The Green Hill Road, from the south-east corner of the City of Adelaide, by way of the Green Hill, to Balhannah.

32. South-Eastern Road.—From South-terrace, Adelaide to MacDonnell Bay, vid Glen Osmond, Crafers, Echunga, Macclesfield, Strathalbyn, Langhorne's Bridge, Wellington, Kingston (Lacepede Bay), Narracoorte, Penola, and Mount Gambier.

33. Robe Town Branch.—From Kingston (Lacepede Bay) to Robe Town (Guichen

Bay).

34. Milang Branch.—From a point on the South-Eastern Road near Belvidere to

Milang.

35. Nairne Branch.—From a point on the South-Eastern Road, near the twelfth mile-post, to a point one mile on the eastern side of the River Murray, via Hahndorf, Littlehampton, Blakiston, Nairne, and Scott's Creek.

36. Mount Barker Branch.—From a point near the twentieth mile-post, on the Nairne Branch, via Mount Barker, Bugle Ranges, and bridge at Cross's, to meet the

road from Strathalbyn to Wellington.

- 37. Woodside Branch.—From junction near fifteenth mile-post on Nairne Branch, via Balhannah, Oakbank, and Woodside, to join Main Eastern Road, No. 31.
- 38. Meadows Branch.—From Echunga to Bull's Creek Road at the Meadows. 39. Bull's Creek Road.—From South-terrace, Adelaide, to Goolwa, vid Unley, Clarendon, Meadows, and Bull's Creek.
- 40. Strathalbyn Branch.—From Strathalbyn to junction with Bull's Creek Road, near Currency Creek.
- 41. Happy Valley Branch.—From near Clarendon to junction with South Road at O'Halloran Hill.
- 42. Kangarilla and McLaren Vale Road.—From Bull's Creek Road, at Kangarilla, to Willunga Branch of Main South Road at McLaren Vale.

43. Lower Meadows and Willunga Road.—The Lower Meadows Road, from its

junction with Bull's Creek Main Road near McHarg's Creek, to Willunga.

- 44. South Road.—From Black Forest Inn, Glenelg Road, to Cape Jarvis, via Mudge's Corner, and through or by Noarlunga, Aldinga Plains, Grant's Corner, and Yankalilla.
- 45. Willunga Branch.—From junction near Noarlunga to Willunga, and thence by way of, or by, the Cut Hill and Hindmarsh Valley to Port Elliot.
- 46. Port Willunga Branch.—From the Township of Willunga to Port Willunga.
  47. Encounter Bay Branch.—From junction with South Road, near Yankalilla, to Victor Harbor and Port Elliot.
- 48. Port Adelaide and Tapley's Hill Road.—From the foot of Tapley's Hill, vid Glenelg, to Port Adelaide.
- 49. Glenelg Road.—From the junction of South and West-terraces, Adelaide, to eastern boundary of Glenelg Municipality.

50. From Robe Town to Penola, or near thereto, by way of MacDonald's.

51. From Forrester's, via Riverton, Saddleworth, and Chinckford, to the Black Springs.

52. From Robe to Narracoorte.

53. From near the twenty-ninth mile-post on the Mount Barker Branch to the North-eastern Road, at Langhorne's Bridge.

54. From Mount Barker to Echunga.
