An Act to amend the Railways Act, 1936-1976.

[Assented to 15th March, 1979]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Railways Act Amendment Act, 1979". Short titles.

(2) The Railways Act, 1936-1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Railways Act, 1936-1979".

2. Section 84 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "consent of the Governor" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "approval of the Minister";

(b) by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "consent of the Governor" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "approval of the Minister";

and

(c) by striking out from subsection (6) the word "Governor" twice occurring and inserting in lieu thereof, in each case, the word "Minister".
