**An Act to amend the Roads (Opening and Closing) Act, 1932.**

*[Assented to 4 September 1986]*

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Roads (Opening and Closing) Act Amendment Act, 1986".

(2) The Roads (Opening and Closing) Act, 1932, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Width of Roads.

2. Section 24 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "twenty-one metres" twice occurring and substituting, in each case, the passage "twenty metres".
