An Act to amend the Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1956.

[Assented to 14th November, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road and Railway Transport Act Amendment Act, 1957". Short titles.

(2) The Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1956, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road and Railway Transport Act Amendment Act, 1930-1957".

(3) The Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 31 thereof:— Enactment of s. 31a of principal Act—

31a. A person shall not be entitled to recover from the Crown, the board, or any Minister of the Crown, or any other authority, or person, any money paid to the board for or pursuant to a licence or permit granted under this Act, or for any other charges under this Act, unless (in addition to proving any other facts necessary to sustain his cause of action) he satisfies the court that his claim to recover such money is just and equitable having regard Claims for recovery of money paid.

to all the circumstances including the extent, if any, to which the charges made by him for the carriage of goods or passengers on such vehicle, have included an amount to recoup him for or provide for the money so paid to the board.
