An Act to authorize the Treasurer to refund certain money paid under the Road and Railway Transport Act Amendment Act, 1956, as charges for the use of public roads.

[Assented to 9th October, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Road Charges (Refunds) Short title. Act, 1958".
- 2. (1) The Treasurer may refund to any person who has Power to make paid charges to the Transport Control Board for the use of roads pursuant to section 27g of the Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1956 an amount equal to the charges so paid.
- (2) Every such refund shall be paid out of the General Revenue of the State and the Treasurer may issue and apply such amounts of the said Revenue as are required for the purpose of making such payments.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
