An Act to amend the Renmark Irrigation Trust Act,
1936-1959.

[Assented to 21st November, 1963.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Renmark Irrigation Trust Act Amendment Act, 1963".

(2) The Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1959, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1963".

(3) The Renmark Irrigation Trust Act, 1936-1959, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 64.

3. Section 64 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection (the preceding part of the section being designated as subsection (1) thereof) :—

(2) The trust may, from time to time, as and when it thinks fit and upon such terms and conditions as are prescribed by regulation, supply by way of special irrigation additional water for irrigation and domestic purposes to ratepayers or other owners or occupiers of land within the district.

4. Section 73 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein the following paragraph after paragraph III thereof :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 73.

IIIa. For fixing terms and conditions under which additional water may be supplied in pursuance of subsection (2) of section 64 and charges to be made therefor.

5. Section 121o of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (2) and (3) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 121o.

(2) The trust shall apply all moneys received as revenue from any such undertaking in payment of the working expenses and cost of maintenance of the undertaking the interest on any moneys borrowed for the purpose of the undertaking and for any other purpose of or relating to the undertaking. Except with the approval of the Minister on the recommendation of the Auditor-General no portion of any moneys received as revenue from any such undertaking shall be applied or expended for any other purpose.

6. Section 121q of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of s. 121q of the principal Act.

7. Section 123 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 123.

(a) by striking out the passage “ten financial years commencing with the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty” therein in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “three financial years commencing with the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four” ;

(b) by striking out the words “seventy-five thousand” in subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words “one hundred and seventy-five thousand” ;

(c) by inserting at the end of the said subsection (1) thereof the following paragraph :—

The payments mentioned in this subsection shall be in addition to the sum of three hundred thousand pounds paid by the Treasurer to the said trust account in respect of the four financial years commencing with the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty, in pursuance of subsection (1) of

section 123 of this Act as amended and in force immediately prior to the commencement of the Renmark Irrigation Trust Act Amendment Act, 1963 ;

- (d) by striking out the words "said financial years" in subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "seven financial years commencing with the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty" ;
- (e) by striking out the words "five hundred thousand pounds" in the said subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof the words "six hundred and fifty thousand pounds" ;
- (f) by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty thousand pounds" in the said subsection (2) and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and seventy-five thousand pounds" ;
- (g) by striking out the word "ten" in subsection (3) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "three" ;
- (h) by inserting at the end of the said subsection (3) thereof the following paragraph :—

The sums which by this section the trust is required to set aside or in respect whereof the trust is required to make arrangements satisfactory to the Treasurer, shall be in addition to the sum of one hundred thousand pounds paid by the trust to the said separate account in respect of the four financial years commencing with the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty in pursuance of subsection (3) of section 123 of this Act as amended and in force immediately prior to the commencement of the Renmark Irrigation Trust Act Amendment Act, 1963 ;

- (i) by striking out subsection (7) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection :—

(7) The amount paid to the trust by way of loan by the Treasurer pursuant to subsection (2) of this section shall be repaid by the trust to the Treasurer with interest computed at the rate of five per centum per annum by equal annual payments

to be made on the thirtieth day of June in each of the eighteen years commencing with the year one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven or the year next following the completion of the purposes of this section, whichever is the earlier. Upon the completion of all the said payments all liabilities of the trust in respect of all the amounts mentioned in subsection (2) of this section including interest shall be deemed finally to have been determined and extinguished.
